


Pakistan Rice Export Forecast Rises to Record While Importing More Wheat

2021/22 Pakistan rice exports are forecast up 450,000 tons to 4.8 million, almost 30 percent higher than the previous year. Favorable export conditions are expected to continue as large stocks, competitive export prices, and strong demand from key markets are expected to spur exports further to 4.9 million tons in 2022/23. Pakistan retains ample supplies following two consecutive record crops, despite hot and dry conditions



delaying the 2022 May/June planting season. The Pakistan Meteorological Department forecasts ample monsoon rains which are expected to be beneficial for this season's harvest. In addition to favorable weather and market conditions, abundant supplies, and the devaluation of the Pakistani rupee have kept its prices globally competitive. Over the past year, Pakistani rice prices have closely mirrored Indian prices, which have been extremely low for almost 2 years; however, strong export demand has caused Pakistani quotes to spike in recent weeks.

Pakistan's top export markets include a diverse group of countries to which it exports different rice varieties, including fragrant long-grain basmati, regular milled, and broken rice. In recent years, Pakistan has emerged as a major supplier to China, the world's largest rice importing and consuming country. In fact, in the first few months of 2022, Pakistan exported more rice to China than Vietnam, the historic top supplier. Pakistan exports both milled rice and broken rice to China, the latter primarily used in feed. Pakistan also



exports competitively priced milled rice to East Africa - particularly Kenya, Mozambique, and Tanzania - and neighboring countries in Central Asia, mainly Afghanistan. Pakistan is also a producer and exporter of basmati rice, a premium product known for its aromatic qualities. Demand for basmati rice has grown in recent years, especially in the European Union and the Middle East. While still facing stiff competition from India, the top global basmati exporter, Pakistan is a significant basmati supplier to the European Union, the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, and the United Kingdom.

Rice is an important food in Pakistan; however, wheat is the principal grain consumed domestically. Unfortunately, the same hot and dry planting conditions that delayed planting of the 2022 rice crop in Punjab and Sindh provinces have adversely affected Pakistan's wheat production.

This month, Pakistan's 2022/23 wheat import forecast has been raised 500,000 tons to 2.5 million as the government has aggressively procured international and domestic wheat. Historically, the government intervenes heavily in wheat production, marketing, and trade to ensure sufficient supplies of a commodity critical to food security. Pakistan's government intervention includes procurement of wheat from the domestic market through price support programs and a mandated



selling price for flour mills, used to intervene in periods of high food inflation. At the provincial level, the government buys wheat from farmers at the support price and then sells it to flour mills at the fixed government price. The amount released from reserves is based on the estimated shortfall of production for the marketing year.

While the 2022/23 crop is on par with historic yield trends, the output was short of the government's production target, leading to some concerns about supply shortages. Output was adversely impacted by early-season fertilizer shortages and a heat wave in March which occurred during a key maturation stage. Procurement began earlier this year and in much larger volumes than usual, causing price spikes in the open market. To counteract rapidly rising prices, the government released wheat from strategic reserves several months early. This has led to concerns that stocks will be much lower by January-March 2023, which has traditionally been the time of the year where the market is more dependent on government intervention. Population growth, high inflation, and higher prices for milk, meat, and fruits have only increased the prominence of wheat-based products in the diet, further exacerbating concerns about available supplies.

These same dynamics have led the government of Pakistan to look to the international market for wheat earlier in the year than expected. The Trading Corporation of Pakistan (TCP), a state-owned enterprise within the Ministry of Commerce, issued two tenders in May and June, each for 500,000 tons of wheat¹. The government also approved the import of up to 3.0 million tons of wheat in order to satisfy domestic consumption and shore up its strategic reserves. Pakistani media has reported that 2.0 million tons of wheat will be purchased from Russia.

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¹ First tender was issued May 17 and purchased on May 31. Second tender was issued on June 23 with no purchases made. TCP issued a new tender for 300,000 tons on July 8.


WHEAT

OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23

Global production is down this month primarily on smaller crops in the European Union, Ukraine, and Argentina and only partially offset by increases for Canada and Russia. Global consumption is lowered this month, mainly on lower feed and residual for the European Union and Ukraine. Ending stocks are revised down mostly on reductions for Ukraine and Pakistan. Imports are raised as higher imports for Algeria, the European Union, Japan, Pakistan, and Vietnam more than offset lower imports for Philippines and the United States. Exports are up for Canada, Brazil, and the United States with reductions for Argentina and the European Union. The U.S. season-average farm price is down 25 cents per bushel to \$10.50.

WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: All U.S. quotes have continued to slide following the June *WASDE* report, reflecting a combination of sustained weakness in export demand for U.S. wheat and mounting harvest pressure. Hard Red Spring (HRS) tumbled \$116/ton from last month to \$387 as more favorable weather improves the production outlook but with relatively low outstanding sales to this point. Hard Red Winter fell \$95/ton to \$388 on an advancing harvest and muted international demand. Soft White Winter (SWW) slid \$68/ton to \$380 ahead of harvest which begins later this month. Soft Red Winter (SRW) declined \$90/ton to \$327, reflecting favorable conditions with the onset of harvest.



Global: Global wheat prices declined significantly since the June WASDE as ongoing winter wheat harvests in the Northern Hemisphere applied downward pressure. Furthermore, various negative macroeconomic factors have heightened concern of a global recession, and the value of the U.S. dollar continues to surge. EU quotes remain the most competitive and have fallen \$62/ton over the past month amidst its winter wheat harvest and the declining euro. Russian quotes slid \$55/ton as changes to the country's export tax calculation to rubles may allow for additional exports and as production forecasts remain favorable after excessive wetness earlier. Canadian quotes experienced the largest drop of \$113/ton as spring wheat plantings continued with improved conditions. U.S. quotes fell \$95/ton from exceptionally high levels as the winter wheat harvest advances quickly despite a slight downward revision to area planted in the NASS Acreage Report. Australian quotes slid \$51/ton as exports slow towards the end of the trade year. Argentine quotes remain the most expensive with old-crop supplies being exhausted but dropped \$59/ton since last month as new-crop plantings are over 50 percent complete.

International Daily FOB Export Bids







MARKET FEATURE

Latin America and Caribbean Wheat Imports to Rebound in 2022/23

Latin America and Caribbean wheat imports² dropped in 2021/22 as major suppliers to the region suffered production shortfalls but are forecast to recover to record levels in 2022/23.






The region's wheat food use has historically expanded in line with population growth. Bread and other wheat products are staple foods, causing demand for wheat grain and flour to increase steadily. While approximately 10 percent of the region's wheat imports are wheat flour and products, the remaining 90 percent of wheat grain imports are primarily consumed by the region's robust milling industry.

Canada, the United States, and Argentina are consistently the top exporters to the region, competing for market share based on exportable supplies and relative prices.

Many Latin American and Caribbean millers prefer higher-protein Canadian or U.S. wheat, but Argentine is typically a more affordable option for millers. Import taxes and tariffs also influence countries' choice of suppliers. For example, tariff-free trade within the Mercosur bloc allows Argentina to export significant volumes of wheat to its neighboring countries. The United States and Canada have also implemented various free trade agreements in the region. For example, the Dominican Republic-Central America-United States Free Trade Agreement has helped U.S. wheat dominate Central American import markets.

In 2021/22, both Canada and the United States faced drought-reduced crops. Canada wheat production dropped nearly 40 percent from 2020/21, causing its exports to Latin America and Caribbean to decline by over 3.0 million tons. Canada primarily exports spring wheat grain to South America, typically capturing majority market shares in Colombia, Peru, and Ecuador.

U.S. wheat production in 2021/22 declined 10 percent from the prior year due to drought conditions impacting the spring, white, and durum crops. However, HRW and SRW account for the majority of U.S. wheat exports to Latin America and Caribbean and production of both was up in 2021/22. The United States was able to maintain exports to the region in 2021/22 and gain market share in markets that typically depend on Canada exports. Argentina, meanwhile, had record wheat production in 2021/22, allowing exports to the region to expand by nearly 2.0 million tons, mostly to Brazil. Furthermore, while Canadian and U.S. wheat export quotes surged due to constrained supplies, Argentine prices were relatively affordable.

Looking forward, Canada wheat production is forecast to rebound in 2022/23 by nearly 60 percent to 34.0 million tons, allowing exports to rebound to Latin America and Caribbean. U.S. wheat exports are also forecast higher with larger production, while Argentina exports are forecast down as Argentine export quotes have surged over the past month due to exhausted supplies. With that in mind, Latin America and Caribbean wheat imports are forecast up by 1.6 million tons in 2022/23.

RICE


OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23

Global rice production is forecast lower this month with reduced production for the European Union, which is forecast lower based on severe drought conditions in Spain and Italy. Global consumption is also down with decreases for Cambodia and Pakistan but still a record. Global stocks are projected to decline, mainly due to a decrease in India's carryover stocks from 2021/22 and higher anticipated demand for Pakistan rice. Imports are forecast up on stronger demand from the European Union, Vietnam, and the United States. Exports are also up, mainly for Cambodia and Pakistan.

OVERVIEW FOR 2021/22

Global rice production is forecast lower this month due to lower average yields for Sri Lanka more than offsetting larger crops for the Philippines and Senegal. Global consumption is projected up, primarily on increases for China, Benin, and the Philippines. Global stocks are down mainly due to decreases for India, Sri Lanka, and Pakistan. Imports are forecast up due to higher demand from China, Vietnam, and the Philippines. Exports are forecast higher primarily for India, Pakistan, and Cambodia.


RICE PRICES



Global: In the past month, U.S. quotes rose \$10 to \$705/ton amid tight supplies. Uruguayan prices remain steady at \$545/ton. Thai quotes fell \$28 to \$428/ton due to large stocks, a weakening Thai baht, and stiff competition from other Asian suppliers. Vietnamese prices fell by \$13 to \$410/ton as market conditions remain little changed from last month. Shrinking the price spread with Thailand and Vietnam, Pakistani quotes rose \$40 to \$420/ton amid steady demand from China. Indian quotes rose minimally by \$5 to \$350/ton and remain the lowest globally with large supplies.

MARKET FEATURE

High Domestic Prices Spur Vietnam's Demand for Cambodia and India Rice



Vietnam is forecast to once again purchase large quantities of rice with imports forecast at 1.1 million tons for 2022. Although down from the record set in 2021 at 1.8 million tons, demand for Cambodia and India rice remains strong amid high domestic rice prices.

Traditionally, Vietnam imports around 400,000-500,000 tons of paddy rice each year from neighboring Cambodia. Earlier this year, in an effort to reduce high domestic prices, the Government of Vietnam released a statement exempting the import tax on 300,000 tons of rice from Cambodia. Cambodia exported roughly 460,000 tons to Vietnam during January through May.

Demand for broken and milled rice from India also remains strong. Imports peaked in the beginning of 2021 due to the gap in prices between Vietnam and India for all types of rice, influenced by high internal transit costs in Vietnam. After domestic Vietnamese prices trended

down, rice imports dropped, more noticeably for milled rice. However, demand for India milled rice is rebounding, likely due to India's low price. In April, India's milled rice exports to Vietnam were priced at \$326/ton. Demand for domestic broken rice has remained steady due to its use as a lower-priced feed alternative. As domestic broken rice prices remain higher than India's rice, Vietnam's importers continue to look towards India to meet demand.

Looking ahead, Vietnam is forecast to import 800,000 tons of rice in 2023. Imports are anticipated to decline year over year but are still above the historical average. With ample supplies, India will remain an affordable alternative.

COARSE GRAINS

OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23


Global corn production is forecast down as crop reductions for Russia, the European Union, and Kenya exceed a gain for Paraguay. Global imports are little changed with smaller forecasts for Costa Rica and several African countries, essentially offsetting increases in Nicaragua and the Philippines. Global exports are up with a higher forecast for Paraguay more than offsetting a decrease for Russia. The U.S. season-average farm price is down 10 cents to \$6.65 per bushel.

OVERVIEW FOR 2021/22

Global corn production is forecast up with increases for Paraguay and the Philippines. Global exports are also forecast up with gains for Ukraine, Canada, the European Union, Paraguay, and Zambia offsetting a decrease for Argentina. Global imports are forecast to increase marginally with gains for Canada and Zimbabwe exceeding minor reductions across Africa, the Middle East, Central America, and Asia. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$5.95 per bushel.

CORN PRICES

Since the June WASDE, major exporters' bids have eased. In the United States, the June 30 release of the NASS *Acreage* report showed planted corn area slightly higher than intentions reported in the March *Prospective Plantings*. Harvested area was also forecast up from the June WASDE assumption. In conjunction with sluggish demand, U.S. bids were down \$20/ton to \$318. Argentine bids were down \$34/ton to \$273 and Brazilian bids were down sharply by \$48/ton to \$283 as plentiful *safrinha* supplies have started to hit the market. Ukrainian bids remain unpublished.

<u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption</u>: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade</u>: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

EU Consolidation:

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as "European Union") and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represent the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

<u>Unaccounted:</u> This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
